Osler House is a fantastic resource that should be protected and developed. I would like to become more involved in Osler as your Treasurer, and here are the key tenets I would commit to.

Systematic approach. This ensures accounts are kept in order, invoices honoured promptly, and individuals reimbursed with minimal delay. I have been developing this systematic approach as Treasurer for the University Wind Orchestra, a position I have held for three years. As a result of this experience I am comfortable dealing with Banks and am aware of University requirements on societies such as Osler House.

Transparency. This provides an incentive for a systematic approach since the accounts are under scrutiny. It also means that you, as a member of Osler House, have the opportunity to examine our outgoings and incomings and to challenge or suggest change where appropriate. I would be keen to establish a quarterly review of the accounts that is made available to all members of Osler House to facilitate this.

Resourcefulness. As I understand it, Osler is currently running at a deficit, and this cannot be maintained. It is no surprise that a facility as fantastic as ours costs a great deal, but I believe there are multiple avenues available to us to increase our revenue. I would be interested in pursuing additional sponsorship and in making Osler available for hire to external bodies – provided such activities do not impact on us students.
